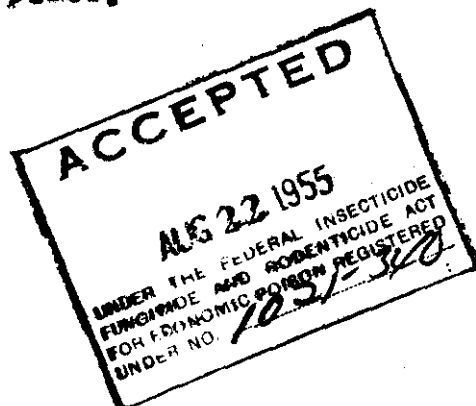
Add one pound of PYROCIDE INTERMEDIATE NO. 3192 to 115.5 pounds of petroleum distillate weighing 6.6 pounds per gallon to produce a spray containing:

Petroleum distillate	115.5
N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide	1.0
Piperonyl butoxide, technical	1.0
Pyrethrins	0.5

Such a spray is harmless to human beings when used in accordance with conventional acceptable directions and leaves no poisonous residue. Such a spray meets the specifications of the Meat Inspection Division, U.S.D.A., as set forth in Memo No. 52, Supplement 8, of Dec. 29, 1951, for control of insects in meat packing plants.
