Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one Bomb for each 10,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Can be used manually or valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press arrow on valve button all the way forward, hooking the catch over the lip of metal rim. For best results, first spray distant rooms manually, spraying toward ceiling. Four to six seconds is ample for average (10'x10'x10') room. Also spray into cracks and crevices. Then'place Bomb on stand or table in center of building with valve locked open, placing newspaper or pad under Bomb. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
