*Di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate100%

DIRECTIONS

MGK REPELLENT 326 may be used in preparing barn or dairy cattle or beef cattle sprays to repel horn flies, stable flies, horse flies (Tabanids), deer flies, house flies, gnats and certain other flying and biting insects.

When MGK REPELLENT 326 is used in an oil spray it should be used with MGK 264 at a 1 to 1 ratio, and the finished spray should contain 2% MGK REPELLENT 326 and 2% MGK 264 on a weight basis. Spray daily or as necessary with the oil base spray to repel horse and deer flies, applying one or two ounces per adult animal.

CAUTION

Keep containers closed tightly. Store in a cool dry place. Keep out of reach of children and domestic animals. Avoid contamination of milk and milk handling equipment.
