Dear Ms. Schiekau;

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. All technical and manufacturing use products **must** include the required statements as per PR Notice 93-10. These statements should appear in the Environmental Hazards section of the label and are in addition to any other required statements.

"Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

"This product is toxic to fish..." or "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes."

2. The "CAUTION" signal word must appear in the precautionary labeling section of the label immediately after the subheading "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".

Warm drum gently to reliquify. Agitation and probing during warming will speed liquification. Do not heat above 120°F. Do not hold at elevated temperatures any longer than necessary. Agitate drum thoroughly before use. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
