The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Label changes:

Revise the first paragraph under the directions for use as follows:

This product may be used only for formulation into insect repellents for application to human skin.

Conditions of Registration:

The Di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate RED, issued 9/23/03, limited production and distribution of MGK Repellent 326 (di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate) for personal insect repellents to 20,000 lbs. of active ingredient per year. In comments submitted on 6/25/04, MGK agreed to an annual production cap of 20,000 lbs. per year for technical di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate to be used as personal insect repellents on human skin. In accordance with this agreement, as a condition of registration, MGK shall limit its production of di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate under this registration (MGK Repellent 326, EPA Reg. No. 1021-461) to 20,000 lbs of active ingredient per year. MGK shall submit to this office annually reports of annual production of this product.

You must submit samples and a copy of the analytical enforcement method to the address specified in the product chemistry review (attached).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Only for formulation into an insect repellent for the following use(s): Indoor residential and indoor non-food areas.

For formulations of this product intended for human use, the maximum percent of active ingredient in any formulation type is 2.5.

This product may not be used to formulate products for the following uses: 1) food producing livestock - direct applications to meat and dairy animals, treatment of occupied premises or when animal food or feed is present; 2) growing crops - edible crops and pre- and post-harvest sprays; 3) fumigated commodities; and 4) aquatic uses.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

NOTE: MGK Repellent 326 may crystallize from exposure to temperatures below 70°F during shipment or storage. The drum may be filled with crystals or a layer of darker liquid over crystals. Warm drum gently to reliquify. Agitation and probing during warming will speed liquification. Do not heat above 120°F. Do not hold at elevated temperatures any longer than necessary. Agitate drum thoroughly before use. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
