In accordance with this agreement, as a condition of registration, MGK shall limit its production of di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate under this registration (MGK Repellent 326, EPA Reg. No. 1021-461) to 20,000 lbs of active ingredient per year. MGK shall Submit to this office annually reports of annual production of this product.

This product may not be used to formulate products for the following uses: 1) food producing livestock - direct applications to meat and dairy animals, treatment of occupied premises or when animal food or feed is present; 2) growing crops - edible crops and pre- and post-harvest sprays; 3) fumigated commodities; and 4) aquatic uses.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

NOTE: MGK Repellent 326 may crystallize from exposure to temperatures below 70°F during shipment or storage. The drum may be filled with crystals or a layer of darker liquid over crystals. Warm drum gently to reliquify. Agitation and probing during warming will speed liquification. Do not heat above 120°F. Do not hold at elevated temperatures any longer than necessary.
