Dear Ms. Sharp:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

General Statement:

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "~~strikethrough~~."

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section comment(s):

2. Replace the existing "PESTICIDE STORAGE:" subsection with "Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals."
3. Revise the existing subsection title "CONTAINER HANDLING:" to read "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:"
4. Insert the following text immediately following the last sentence in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th paragraphs within the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" subsection as follows: "Offer for recycling if available for reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

This product may be used only for formulation into insect repellents for application to human skin.

For formulations of this product intended for human use, the maximum percent of active ingredient in any formulation type is 2.5.

This product may not be used to formulate products for the following uses: 1) food producing livestock - direct applications to meat and dairy animals, treatment of occupied premises or when animal food or feed is present; 2) growing crops - edible crops and pre- and post-harvest sprays; 3) fumigated commodities; and 4) aquatic uses.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

NOTE: MGK Repellent 326 may crystallize from exposure to temperatures below 70°F during shipment or storage. The drum may be filled with crystals or a layer of darker liquid over crystals. Warm drum gently to reliquify. Agitation and probing during warming will speed liquification. Do not heat above 120°F. Do not hold at elevated temperatures any longer than necessary. Agitate drum thoroughly before use. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

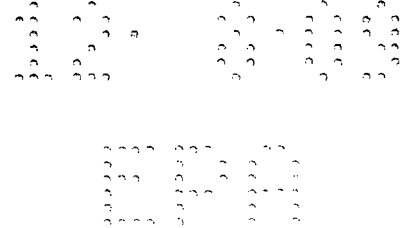

Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. ~~Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of container in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.~~

Triple rinse as follows for containers of 5 Gallons or less: Empty the remaining content into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with diluent and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Triple rinse as follows for containers greater than 5 Gallons: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with diluent. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat his procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.



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
