The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of PYROCIDE® Intermediate 5734 (EPA Reg. No. 1021-567), in connection the DEET Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED), and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

General Comment(s):

- Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."
- Insert the following statement so that it appears immediately preceding the Ingredient Statement: "Only For Formulation into an Insect Repellent for the Following Use(s): Indoor Residential or Indoor Non-Food Areas."

3. Replace the 1st two (2) lines of the Ingredient Statement with:

4. Based on the applicable acute toxicity review, delete the line labeled as "IF INHALED:"

<u>Precautionary Statements section, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection</u> comment(s):

To facilitate inclusion of revised language from the acute toxicity review completed for this product, replace this section with: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or on clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

Directions for Use section comment(s):

Replace the 1st statement in this section with: "Only for formulation into an insect repellent for 6. the following use(s): indoor residential or indoor non-food areas."

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

- Replace the "STORAGE:" subsection with: "PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep this product in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area."
- 8. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-1, replace the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" subsection with: "CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."

NOTE: This DEET product is not being re-registered under FIFRA section 4(q) at this time.

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
