The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection the **MGK 326 RED**, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

McLaughlin Gormley King Company should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) documents for products containing:

- MGK 264 was published in the *Federal Register* July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143) Page 42381-42383).

As a result of this RED, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing MGK 264.

You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. 

For formulations of this product intended for human use, the maximum percent of active ingredient in any formulation type is 2.5.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).
