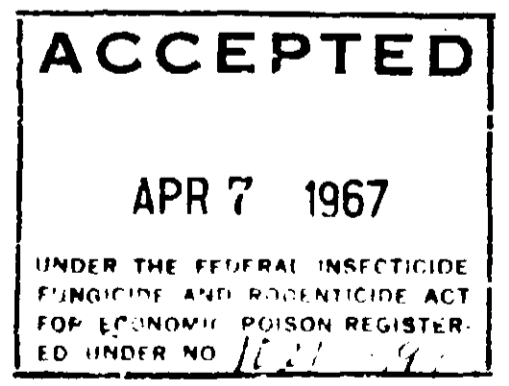

For temporary protection of dairy cattle, beef cattle and horses from horn flies, stable flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

Directions for use

Hold dispenser 18 to 24 inches from animal. Apply in sweeping motion from front of animal to the rear, including legs. Use a dosage of one to two seconds per animal. Repeat daily, or as needed.

Wash teats before milking dairy cows.



Never store dispenser where temperatures may exceed 120°F. Do not puncture or incinerate dispenser. Do not contaminate milk or milk handling equipment with the spray.
