DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To operate:

Remove cap. Hold can upright. Press nozzle directed at insects or area to be sprayed. Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

Roaches, Ants, Silverfish, Waterbugs, Spiders, Crickets:

Spray directly on insects where possible. Also spray until wet their trails and surfaces wherever insects may breed or congregate such as under sinks, drainboards, stoves, refrigerators, in cabinets, around baseboards, door sills and frames, window frames, garbage cans, garages, and out-buildings. Re-treat as necessary.

Fleas in Buildings and Pet Quarters:

Spray thoroughly floors, walls, rugs, carpets, cracks, crevices, sleeping quarters of pets or other infested areas. Re-treat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles:

Apply to floor areas and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices, and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat both the underside and topside of infested carpets. Spray inside of trunks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Re-treat as necessary.

Bedbugs:

Spray mattress and bedding lightly including seams and folds. Spray bed frames, springs, along baseboards, carpet edges, cracks and hiding places about rooms. Apply liberally to inside walls and floors of laundry trucks.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths, Wasps:

Spray surfaces until wet where these insects alight or congregate such as walls of porches, garages, house foundations, etc.

Fleas and Ants Outdoors:

Spray to wet localized infestations of these insects. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Re-treat as necessary.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contacts. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils, food, feed, and water supplies. Remove fish bowls and bird cages from room during spraying.
