DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Flying Moths: Close all windows and doors and direct spray upward into the center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for the average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Ants: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails, over window and doorsills and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Contents under Pressure. Store upright in a cool place (not over 120°F). Do not place on hot surface. Do not puncture can. Never throw in fire or incinerator.

Cover or remove food and food utensils before application. May stain finished surfaces if sprayed too closely.
