DIRECTIONS

FOR MANUFACTURING PURPOSES

Pack 40 parts of PYROCIDONE, 10 parts of Formic Acid, 10 parts of Acetic Acid, 10 parts of Hydrogen Peroxide and 35 parts of potassium permanganate in a suitable container.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
