- For 120,000 gallons of water - 10 pounds of granules
- For 12,000 gallons of water - 1 pound of granules
- For 6,000 gallons of water - 1/2 pound of granules
- For 500 gallons of water - 1 tablespoon of granules

Repeat applications at 7-day intervals, or as necessary to keep mosquito larvae under control.

This Intermediate is designed for use at 1.0% (wt.) with .5% malathion or methoxychlor, petroleum distillate and propellant in the preparation of a pressurized spray for use on dogs.
