HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

WARNING

Harmful if swallowed. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, or on skin or clothing. Wear goggles, face shield, or safety glasses when handling this material. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.

Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. Food processing operations do not have to be stopped while applying a wet spray with care and in accordance with the directions and cautions above in those establishments which do NOT operate under Federal meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg products inspection programs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPACE SPRAY TO KILL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES: Dilute three parts of concentrate with 97 parts of water (in case of dilution for packaging ready-to-use products, use distilled water or deionized water only). Mix thoroughly until a uniform, clear emulsion forms. Mist all parts of the room or area at a dosage of one fluid ounce of diluted spray per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete.

CONTACT SPRAY TO KILL CRICKETS, COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS AND EXPOSED FORMS OF CRAWLING GRAIN PESTS: Dilute 4 parts of concentrate with 96 parts of water (in case of dilution for packaging ready-to-use products, use distilled water or deionized water only). Mix thoroughly until a uniform, clear emulsion forms. For cockroaches, waterbugs, and crickets, apply as a coarse spray to all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes and all places where these insects nest, contacting as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat applications as often as necessary. For Grain Weevils, Cadelles, Grain Moths, Flour Beetles and Grain Mites, apply as a coarse spray to all infested surfaces, insect hiding places, and insect runways at the rate of one gallon of diluted spray on 750 square feet of area.

OR USE IN HORSE BARN, KENNELS AND OTHER FARM STRUCTURES OR BUILDINGS HOUSING ANIMALS: Dilute this concentrate just prior to use as follows:

0.10% Pyrethrins - Add 4 parts concentrate to 96 parts water.

0.50% Pyrethrins - Add 20 parts concentrate to 80 parts water.

TO KILL GNATS, HORN FLIES, HORSE FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND STABLE FLIES: Add concentrate to tank and add water to obtain desired dilution. Mix well. Dispense diluted concentrate through automatic spraying system. Set nozzles to deliver 1 ounce liquid per minute. Locate nozzles to cover maximum 2,000 cubic feet of space. Set timer to operate two three-minute cycles per 24 hours.

Do not pack diluted product in cans - brown glass bottles are preferred. This concentrate does not emulsify spontaneously; it must be agitated thoroughly.

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse or equivalent and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and Local procedures.
