Purpose This submission revises the label for this product, under sec 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), to conform to PR Notices 2005-1 and 2005-5, to remove the unneeded "Physical or Chemical Hazards" section, and to modify the "Storage and Disposal" section to conform to the Label Review Manual.

Labeling The labeling submitted with the above letter is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following change, before you ship the product.

1. Under "CAUTION", add the sentence, "Causes moderate eye irritation." after "Harmful if absorbed through skin."
2. In front of "General Information", repeat the statement at the top of your label: "A vertebrate repellent and training aid for formulation into registered end-use products for use in indoor and outdoor residential areas to control dogs and cats."

Existing stocks Stocks of product with existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.
