Antidote: If swallowed, give a table spoon full salt in a glass of water and repeat until vomit is clear. Give not a full glass of water or weak coffee, tea, or fruit juice. Administer activated charcoal, 2-4 grams per pound of body weight, if available. Consult a physician.

If on the skin wash with large amounts of soap and water. If inhaled remove the victim to fresh air. Keep him warm and quiet. Call a doctor.

If in the eyes wash with large amounts of water. Call a doctor.

If on clothing, remove and wash with soap and water. Call a doctor.

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit is clear. Have victim lie down and keep him warm and quiet. Call a physician immediately. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

If on the skin wash with large amounts of soap and water. If inhaled remove the victim to fresh air. Keep him warm and quiet. Call a physician immediately.

This material is toxic to fish and other wildlife. Do not contaminate any body of water with empty cans, containers, spillage or leakage.
