Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label in response to the DEET RED and, PR Notice 2001-1 is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Note, the comments listed below are a result of a review of the label submitted on August 21, 2003.

1) Change the Ingredient Statement to read:

ACTIVE INGREDIENT
DEET..... 98.11%
OTHER INGREDIENTS..... 1.89%

2) Change the Precautionary Statement to read as follows:

Precautionary Statements

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

3) Add the following to the First Aid Statement:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

- * Take off contaminated clothing.
- * Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- * Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.


The Confidential Statements Of Formula date June 8, 2001 for the basic and alternate formulas are acceptable and have been placed into the file for this product.
