- 2. Insert the following text as a new row at the end of the existing First Aid section as follows: "Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
- 3. In the Precautionary Statements section, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection, replace the 5th section with: "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 4. Replace the Storage and Disposal section with:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flames.
