FOR MANUFACTURING USE ONLY

Dilute 11 parts of PYROCIDE INTERMEDIATE 6772 with 89 parts of soft water. Agitate thoroughly until a semi-clear stable emulsion results. Package in tinted glass or semi-opaque containers. Do not package in cans.
