Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillates. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Do not apply directly to food. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply space sprays while food processing is underway. Food processing operations do not have to be stopped while applying a wet spray with care in accordance with the directions and cautions above in those establishments which do NOT operate under Federal meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg products inspection programs. After spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash with an acceptable detergent solution and rinse with potable water to remove all traces of contamination on the equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment and thoroughly washed with an acceptable detergent and rinsed with potable water.

Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

### Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

### Physical or Chemical Hazards

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats: Close room and discharge spray mist vigorously in all parts of the room, using about 2 or 3 ounces for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Leave room closed for at least ten minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Fleas (Infesting Premises): Remove and destroy animal's bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely, forcing the spray into all cracks and about the room. Repeat when re-infested.

To Kill Grain Weevils, Cadelles, Grain Moths, Flour Beetles and Grain Mites (Accessible Stages): Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect hiding places and insect runways at the rate of 1 gallon of this material on 750 square feet of area, equivalent to spraying to the point of run-off. Repeat when necessary. For Flying Moths and Beetles, treat as for Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats (see above).

To Kill Roaches and Waterbugs: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as is necessary.

particular attention to folds and seams. Interior surfaces of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks should be regularly sprayed. The treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in a mothtight container.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or Local procedures.

**Container Disposal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and Local procedures.
