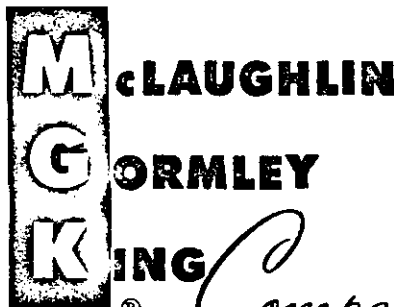

DIRECTIONS

FOR MANUFACTURING USE ONLY

Use at the rate of 20% concentrate with 76% deionized water and 4% N2O to make a pressurized spray for use on pets.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe vapors. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Use with adequate ventilation. Wash with soap and water after using. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.

This spray is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not contaminate any body of water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not re-use empty drum. Destroy by crushing and burying in a safe place or return to drum reconditioning service.
