
Dear Ms. Schiekau;

1. Since the product is formulated for Manufacturing Use Only, remove the Environmental Hazard statements "For Terrestrial Uses, do not....." watermark", and "Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur"; these statements imply that the product is registered as an "end-use" product for outdoor use patterns.

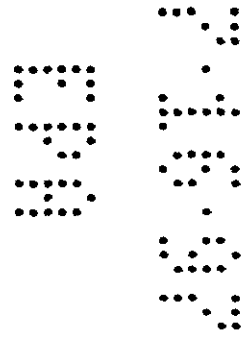
