Directions for Use

This emulsifiable concentrate is designed for dilution with water and application to paper at the rate of 117 mg Dorrban 603/acetate per square foot. This dosage will give 5 mg pyrethrins and 50 mg piperonyl butoxide per square foot. Treated paper is to be used as the outer ply of multivall paper bags of 50 lbs or more capacity. Paper so treated must be labeled per requirements of EPA, Pesticides Regulation Division.

Keep out of reach of children

Hazardous if swallowed. Do not store, pour or spill near an open flame. Keep container tightly closed. Store in a cool place. Agitate container well before use.
