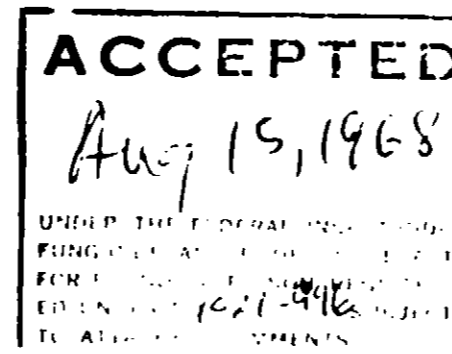


ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

- Pyrethrins
- *Piperonyl butoxide, technical
- 10-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide
- **Dieldrin, technical
- ***Rohmco
- ****2,2-dichlorovinyl dimethyl phosphate
- * Related compounds
- Neotoluene distillate

INERT INGREDIENTS:



- ... of 1.6% (n-butylcarbitol)(2-propylpiperonyl) ether and 10% 2-methyl-2-butanol
- ... in insecticide synergist.
- **equivalent to 12.5% octachloro-4,7-methanotetrahydroindole and 0.57% related compounds
- *** 0-10-ethyl 0-(2,4,5-trichlorophenyl) phosphorothiolate (from technical grade), 10.5 wt. %
- ****from 2.92% (wt.) of dichlorovinyl dimethyl phosphate (DDVP).

DIRECTIONS

FOR RECOMMENDED USE ONLY

Use at 7.0% with approved solvents and propellants with a valve to give large, white, spray particles for a spot-treatment roach and ant product.

This formulation should be stored under a cool condition at 60°-70°F, and the contents should be used promptly after the container has been opened. Whenever possible, DDVP formulation should be stored in full containers. Warm contents thoroughly to room temperature and agitate thoroughly before use if this drum has been exposed to below freezing weather.

Keep away from open flame. Keep container closed tight.

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth or on clothing. Do not breathe vapor or spray. Wash exposed areas of body with soap and water. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Do not apply to humans. Do not use in homes. Prolonged exposure to fumes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water before eating or drinking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and water before reuse. Wear rubber gloves, goggles, protective clothing and goggles when working with this material. For a list of registered distributors go to the U.S. Department of Agriculture for protection against insects. Keep all unproducted contents out of operational areas.

Antidote: If swallowed, give a tablespoon of water in a glass of milk and repeat at 15 minute intervals. Have victim lie down and keep him warm and quiet. Give activated charcoal. Atropine is antidote.

If on skin wash with large amounts of soap and water. If inhaled remove and victim to fresh air. Keep him warm and quiet.
