By Notification, we are updating the storage and disposal statement per PR-Notice 2004-7. This product is a manufacturing use product that is not diluted prior to use, therefore we have not added detailed rinsing instructions per §156.146. We have however, per Nancy Fitz' recommendation maintained our current instructions to triple rinse the container before disposing or offering for reconditioning or recycling. A copy of Nancy's recommendation is enclosed for your convenience.

Enclosed are two (2) copies of the label. One (1) copy has changes highlighted.

This amendment is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA." Hello Tom,

I am responding instead of Kimberly because she is not working primarily on implementing the container-containment regulations any more.

The requirement for the residue removal statements for nonrefillable containers only applies to dilutable pesticides in rigid containers. In the October 2008 amendments to the container-containment regulations, we added a definition for dilutable to §156.3 and §165.3. Specifically, "dilutable means that the pesticide product's labeling allows or requires the pesticide product to be mixed with a liquid diluent prior to application or use."

The key to applying this definition to MUPs is the phrase "prior to application or use." While it depends on the specific labels for your MUPs, our understanding is that MUPs are rarely diluted prior to use.

So, if your MUP is not dilutable, the label is not required to comply with the detailed rinsing procedures in §156.146. However, we recommend that you maintain your current storage and disposal instructions or include the simple statement that you mentioned below - "Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying."

If your MUP is dilutable, you have the option of requesting a modification to the rinsing instructions per §156.144(d), which says:

"EPA may, on its own initiative or based on data submitted by any person, modify or waive the requirements of this section through §156.156, or permit or require alternative labeling statements." To do this, you would need to submit a label amendment - you cannot request a waiver or modification through notification per PR Notice 2007-4.

In either case, the MUP labels needs to include the "nonrefillable container type" instructions in §156.140(a), which are: (1) the phrase "Nonrefillable container."; (2) a statement about reuse; (3) instructions about recycling or reconditioning; and (4) a batch code as well as general container disposal instructions.

These are uses for which the USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of their registration; and uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with the USEPA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
