General Comment(s):

1. In order to incorporate required label changes from the acute toxicity review completed for this product, revise all instances of the signal word "WARNING" to read "CAUTION" throughout the subject label.

First Aid Statement (Table) subsection comment(s):

2. Split the last row within this table into 2 separate rows to read as follows:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate – vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. For information regarding medical emergencies or pesticide incidents, call at 1-888-740-8712.

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

3. Revise this subsection to read "Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. If we do not receive an amended label in response to this letter, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

PLEASE NOTE: This product is <u>not</u> being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.
