DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR MANUFACTURING USE ONLY

Pack a dispenser for pressurized products with 20% (wt.) Concentrate 6996 and 80% (wt.) 50/50 blend of dichlorodifluoromethane and trichloromonofluoromethane to produce a spray for pets.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact with skin wash thoroughly with soap and water. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Use with plenty of ventilation. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Agitate thoroughly in drum before use. If received in cold weather allow to come to room temperature before agitation. Inspect interior of drum before use to be sure all ingredients are in solution. Keep drum sealed when not in use.
