PYROCIDE® Intermediate 6982
EPA Registration No. 1021-1095

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Change the signal word from "WARNING" to "DANGER." In addition to the word "DANGER," the word "PELIGRO" is required.
- Under the ingredients statement, there must be four asterisks next to "Other Ingredients," which corresponds with the notation "Contains petroleum distillate."
- Add the following statements to the First Aid section:
 - o "Contains an N-methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase."
 - o "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
- Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section as follows:
 - o DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if absorbed through the skin. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. [Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing, and goggles when using this product.] Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.


(Regarding the bracketed sentence above which appears on the current label, please note that the designation of personal protective equipment of manufacturing use products falls under the jurisdiction of OSHA.)

- Under the Directions for Use, revise the second sentence so it reads, "Use PYROCIDE® Intermediate 6982 at the rate of 17.00% with approved solvents, carriers, and, in the case of pressurized products, propellants in the manufacture of insecticide sprays.
- Under the Directions for Use, add the following statements immediately after the sentence "It is a violation of Federal Law...":
 - o NOT for formulation into any product that can be sprayed on indoor residential use sites.
 - o This product may only be used to formulate products for the following uses: all commercial indoor, food, non-food, and institutional use areas.

Approval of this labeling amendment does not constitute approval of your application for reregistration of this product. Product reregistration is currently pending and future labeling amendments and/or additional data may be required.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use PYROCIDE® Intermediate 6982 at the rate of 17.00% with approved solvents (or approved solvents and propellants) to produce residual sprays for roaches and ants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Storage: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
