Subject: Amendment - Delete Epichlorhydrin  
PYROCIDE Intermediate 6779  
EPA Registration No. 1021-1107  
Your submission dated July 18, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The following changes should be made at the actual label printing since you are making a number of other revisions at this time:

1. Replace "For Manufacturing Use Only" (which means for incorporation into a non-insecticidal product) with "An Insecticide For Formulating Use Only", which is the real intent of this product.
2. Relocate the signal words DANGER and POISON plus the associated skull and crossbones symbol to appear directly under the footnotes of the ingredients statement.
3. Add the following to the Directions For Use: "Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products."
4. Add the master heading PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS and the subheading HAZARDS TO HUMANS over the paragraph beginning "This material is poisonous, etc."
5. The respirator advice should be revised to reflect the current names of the regulating agencies as follows:

Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) for pesticide application under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11 for protection against dichlorvos.

6. Revise the last sentence of the It Swallowed advice to read:  
"Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person."
5. Add "Apply artificial respiration if necessary" to the It Inhaled advice.
6. Add the subheading ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS over the fish and wildlife precautions and revise the text of this section to read:

This product is toxic to fish and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

7. Update the Storage and Disposal section, complete with appropriate headings and subheadings according to PR Notice 83-3.

Please submit 5 copies of the revised labeling within 75 days.
