PYROCIDE INTERMEDIATE 7024 is designed to be used at 2.5% (wt.) in the manufacture of liquid sprays or pressurized products - such products to be used as spot residual treatment to control roaches and certain other insects.

WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
