DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product may not be used to formulate products for the following uses: 1) food producing livestock - direct applications to meat and dairy animals, treatment of occupied premises or when animal food or feed is present, 2) growing crops - edible crops and pre- and post-harvest sprays, 3) fumigated commodities and 4) aquatic uses.

This product is to be used with appropriate solvents, carriers, and in the case of pressurized products, propellents in the manufacture of insecticide sprays for the following uses: domestic indoor (household), domestic outdoor (household/ornamentals), greenhouses, commercial industrial uses, treatments of animals not intended for food (pets), and terrestrial non-food uses (lawns and grounds).

Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies.

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

<u>PESTICIDE DISPOSAL</u>: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of container in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Triple rinse as follow for containers of 5 Gallons or less: Empty the remaining contents in to application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into the application equipment or a mix tank or stop rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Triple rinse as follows for containers greater than 5 Gallons: Empty the remaining contents into the application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ½ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolutions, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.

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
