Dear Ms. Zielinski:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

Ingredient Statement:

1. Delete the word "technical" listed after "Piperonyl butoxide."
2. Add the word "TOTAL" below "other ingredients."

First Aid section:

3. Relocate the line containing "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING" to appear as the second line.

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section (paragraph 1):

4. Delete the first 3 sentences and replace with "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled."
5. Replace "or using tobacco" with "using tobacco or using the toilet."

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section (paragraph 2):

6. Delete the 2nd sentence and replace with "Wear chemical-resistant gloves such as such as Barrier Laminate, Nitrile Rubber, Neoprene Rubber, Natural Rubber, or Viton; protective clothing: coveralls worn over short-sleeved shirt and short pants, socks, and chemical-resistant footwear; and protective eyewear such as goggles, face shield, or safety glasses when working with this material."

Storage and Disposal:

- 7. Due to the flammability concern of this product, delete the "Storage" subsection in its entirety and replace with "Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flames."

- 8. Since PYROCIDE® is a Toxicity Category 1 primary eye irritant, delete the existing "Pesticide Disposal" subsection in its entirety and replace with "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."
