
The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Add the Spanish signal word "PELIGRO" next to "DANGER."
- Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section, revise the fifth sentence so it reads, "Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing."
- Under the Directions for Use, add the following statement: "NOT for formulation into any product that can be sprayed on indoor residential use sites."
- Under the Directions for Use, revise the list of use sites as follows: "This product may only be used to formulate products for the following uses: all commercial indoor, food, non-food, and institutional use areas."

Approval of this labeling amendment does not constitute approval of your application for reregistration of this product. Product reregistration is currently pending and future labeling amendments and/or additional data may be required.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. IF IN EYES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF SWALLOWED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
IF INHALED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance. Then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Contains an N-methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase. Solvent may present aspiration hazard. Atropine by injection is antidotal and should be administered only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition have appeared. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational areas.
