Aromatic petroleum distillate	40.00%

INERT INGREDIENTS:

DIRECTIONS

Dilute with water as directed in the SPRAY CHART and spray thoroughly, hitting as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

EVER GREEN SPRAY contains spreader. Additional soap or spreader is not necessary. Measure carefully and mix well. Recommended dilutions are adequate; do not make stronger solutions. Mix only enough for immediate use. Use a sprayer and nozzle to give a coarse, driving spray rather than a fine mist.

Spraying should begin when the first insects appear. Do not wait until the plants are heavily infested. EVER GREEN SPRAY can be sprayed at any season of the year.

EVER GREEN SPRAY cannot be used with alkaline insecticides and fungicides. Do not use EVER GREEN SPRAY with arsenic sprays or on plants having arsenical residue as the emulsifier reacts chemically with arsenates and burns the foliage.
