This Intermediate is designed to be used at the rate of 12.5% (wt.) with approved solvents and propellents in the manufacture of pressurized roach and ant sprays.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

MAY BE POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
