

Dear Ms. Schlekau,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The statements "Keep Out of Reach of Children" and "Warning." must be presented on the front display panel, but outside of the box enclosing the "First Aid" title and statements. Since this is a Manufacturing Use Product (MUP), formulators may misinterpret the information as requirements for enclosure within the First Aid box as a necessary part of the "First Aid" statement. The affected language statements are exclusive FIFRA requirements, independent of any First Aid statements, and positioning is mandated by 40 CFR, and the Label Review Manual.
