DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply enough liquid to completely cover the hair and scalp or other louse-infested areas, except the eyelashes and eyebrows. Rub in. Allow to remain for no longer than 10 minutes. Wash with plenty of soap or warm water. Shampoo may be used, if desired. Remove dead lice and their eggs from hair with fine-toothed comb. Repeat as necessary, but not to exceed two consecutive applications in 24 hours.


