**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Because of the small micron-size particles emitted from the MICRO-GEN, Mini Leco or other cold aerosol foggers, this dual synergized insecticidal formulation is extremely effective on those insects listed. The small particle size permits greater insect-insecticide contact than previously attainable by other methods of space spraying.

Prior to application, close all doors and windows. Turn off air-conditioning or ventilating systems. Cover or remove all food and food handling surfaces.

Space Spray to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Using a spraying device similar to the Micro-Gen or Mini Leco, apply 1/2 ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of room space. The applicator should be centrally located or move around the room as necessary to achieve uniform distribution of the insecticide mist. Vacate premises and leave room closed for one hour. ventilate room thoroughly prior to re-entry. Repeat as necessary for control.

Contact Spray to Kill Roaches, Silverfish, Waterbugs, Earwigs, Ants, Spiders, and Beetles in Sheltered Situations: With equipment described above, apply the spray into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, behind pipes and in all places where these insects shelter. Contact as many insects as possible. Do not allow spray to contact stored food. Repeat dosage as necessary for control. Leave the room closed for one hour. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate area before re-entry.
