**Space Spray to Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths:** Use a mechanical sprayer that gives particles of aerosol size. Apply 1/2 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of room space. The applicator should be centrally located or move around the room as necessary to achieve uniform distribution of the insecticide mist. Vacate premises and leave room closed for one hour. 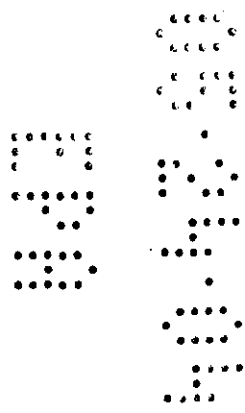
