DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General: This Concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which give particle size of aerosol size.

INDOOR USE:

Kills the accessible stages of house flies, house flies, and mosquitoes in homes, restaurants, food processing plants, warehouses, and industrial installations. Close rooms, turn off all ventilating systems. Use an aerosol spraying device to disperse this product. Do not apply to cold fruit directly. Spray directly into the room frequented by these insects. Apply to areas as follows: Spray into the air above the traps at a rate of 1/2 gal. of spray per 50,000 cu. ft. of space. Repeat application every 30 days. Leave room closed for one hour after application. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate before reentry. Infested stored food should be inspected or treated by other effective methods using an approved product intended for this purpose.

Kills the accessible stages of mosquitoes. Apply to areas where mosquitoes breed: in food warehouses, storage rooms, and in other areas. Close rooms, turn off all ventilating systems. Use an aerosol spraying device to direct spray into cracks, under pallets and around stacks of packaged goods. Apply as many insects as possible. Then spray at the rate of one fluid ounce of spray per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Repeat applications as necessary. Leave room closed for one hour after application. Do not remain in the treated areas and ventilate before reentry. Infested packages should be inspected or treated by other effective methods using an approved product intended for this purpose.

To Kill Roaches, Cockroaches, Fleas, and Beetles: Apply in crevices of perimeter equipment, under sinks, in corners, behind pipes, and in all places where these insects hide. Contact as many insects as possible. Do not allow spray to contact stored food.

OUTDOOR USE:

To Kill Fleas, Earwig Larvae, and Beetles in Open Areas and Pastures: Use undiluted spray when the temperature is 60° or 100° and the wind velocity is approx. 1 to 5 mph. With ULV aerosol equipment, spray at a dosage rate of 10 ounces per minute upwind of the area to be controlled. Treat shrubbery and vegetation where mosquitoes may rest. Shrubby and vegetation around stagnant pools, marshy areas, and ponds may be treated. Application of this product to any body of water is prohibited.

If the equipment is truck-mounted, keep the speed at approximately 5 mph and treat a swath width of no more than 300 feet. Machines that could be used should produce particles in the 5 to 30 micron range. The name of a company that determines droplet size will be supplied on request.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Wear mask or respirator of a type recommended by the U.S. Bureau of Mines to give adequate protection against this material. Wear protective clothing. Wash hands, arms and face with soap and water after handling and before re-use.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Do not reuse drum. Return to distributor or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

Mix well in container before each use. Keep container closed and store in a cool, dry place. DO NOT USE OR SPILL IN OR ON WATER.
