

STORAGE OF CONCENTRATE

Store concentrate in a cool, dry place with the container tightly closed to protect it from heat and freezing!

Concentrate is available in 5-gallon and 1-gallon containers. All containers are available at temperatures above 40 F. Concentrate is not to be frozen and is ready to use. Do not store concentrate in the same container used to protect

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MIXING AND DILUTION

For use in areas where deer, elk, mule deer, black-tailed deer, and Roosevelt elk are present, dilute concentrate with water to form a 1% solution.

For use in areas where mule deer, black-tailed deer, and Roosevelt elk are present, dilute concentrate with water to form a 0.5% solution.

For use in areas where black-tailed deer, mule deer, and Roosevelt elk are present, dilute concentrate with water to form a 0.25% solution.
