### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). ### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DILUTION:** This concentrate is designed for dilution with either water or oil. Depending on severity of infestation, dilute as follows:

**HEAVY INFESTATION:** Mix 4 ounces of Concentrate per gallon of water or petroleum distillates (.50% chlorpyrifos spray).

**LIGHT INFESTATION:** Mix 2 ounces of Concentrate per gallon of water or petroleum distillates (.25% chlorpyrifos spray).

**NOTE:** Water dilution should not be stored for future use.

Synergized pyrethrin in this product will give fast knockdown and kill of the listed insects contacted by the spray. The maximum effectiveness from chlorpyrifos will be apparent 4 to 7 days post treatment.

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after each treatment.

**DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product before re-entering treated areas.

**Flies and Mosquitoes:** Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the homes. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
