DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General: This Concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which give particles of aerosol size. A method for determining particle size is available upon request.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 1 oz. of undiluted Concentrate per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Dead insects should be swept up and discarded in trash.

To Kill the Accessible Stages of INDIAN MEAL MOTH, DRIED FRUIT BEETLE, and CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE in dried fruit products, storage areas or processing areas. Close room or warehouse and shut off all ventilating systems. Do not apply to dried fruit directly. Direct spray into areas of the room frequented by these insects, hitting as many insects as possible. Then spray into the air above the trays at a rate of 1/2 gallon of spray per 50,000 cubic feet of space. Repeat application every 30 days. Leave room closed for one hour after application. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate before re-entry. Infested stored dried fruit should be fumigated or treated by other effective methods using an approved product intended for this purpose.

To Kill the Accessible Stages of RICE WEEVIL, YELLOW MEALWORM CADELLE, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLE, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTH, MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTH, and INDIAN MEAL MOTH in food warehouses, storage rooms, railroad boxcars, trucks, and similar areas. Close room or warehouse and shut off all ventilating systems. Direct spray into corners, under pallets and around stacks of packaged goods, hitting as many insects as possible. Then spray at the rate of one fluid ounce of spray per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Repeat applications as necessary. Leave room closed for one hour after application. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate prior to re-entry. Infested package goods should be fumigated or treated by other effective means, using an approved product intended for this purpose.

To Kill ROACHES, SILVERFISH, EARWIGS, ANTS, and SPIDERS. Apply in aerosol equipment adjusted to coarse spray. Apply the spray into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, behind pipes, and in all places where these insects hide, at the rate of 1/4 gal./1000 square feet of wall space, or point of run-off.
