May be used in unoccupied cargo holds of aircraft.

To Kill Caribbean Fruit Flies, Houseflies, Gnats and Mosquitoes: Use while aircraft is on ground prior to takeoff. Stop the ventilation system for a period of not less than three (3) minutes after spraying. Spray ten (10) grams (10 seconds) per 1,000 cubic feet. Push button to spray, moving arm from side to side in a sweeping motion. Spray all spaces.

FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VANS, SHIPS AND IN TENTAGE**FOR USE BY DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PERSONNEL ONLY**

To Kill Flying Insects (Houseflies, Gnats and Mosquitoes): Close space to be treated. Release three (3) feet from surface, holding can above the head. Moving the can about while spraying aids in dispersal. Ten (10) seconds of spraying is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10 feet x 10 feet x 10 feet). Keep treated area closed for at least thirty (30) minutes. Ventilate area before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring cockroaches. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces and where these pests are suspected of hiding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
