The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

PR Notice 97-5 states that the ingredient statement may use the common name phenothrin in lieu of or in addition to the chemical name.

This product contains petroleum distillate "in any amount". Revise the If Swallowed First Aid Statement to read as follows:

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

In lieu of the statements "Uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements" and "Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies," use one of the following statements from PR Notice 94-1:

"This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with U.S. EPA

data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses(s)" or

"This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses."

Revise the pesticide disposal statement to read as follows:


Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Revise the Container disposal statement to read as follows:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
