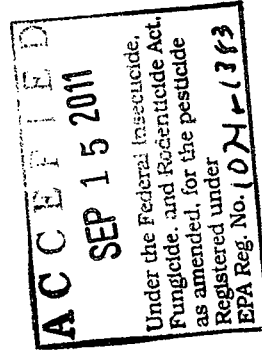

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
