The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

PR Notice 97-5 states that the ingredient statement may use the common name phenothrin in lieu of or in addition to the chemical name.

Remove from the Precautionary Statements the following statements, which contradict the First Aid Statements:

Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard.
In case of contact, flush eyes with plenty of water.
Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Add the word "Combustible" before the statement "Do not use or store near heat or open flame."


