IN PRESSURIZED TANK SPRAYERS FOR WETTING CONTACT SPRAY To kill the listed insects, the diluted spray should be used as follows at a rate of 1 gallon pe J0 square feet of surface area.

<u>To Kill Ants. Centipedes. Cockroaches and Crickets</u>: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry

<u>To Kill Carpet Beetles</u>: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, and areas under furniture and wherever these pests are seen or suspected.

<u>To Kill Exposed Forms Of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, And Saw-Toothed Grain</u> <u>Beetles</u>: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Apply as a coarse wet spray to all other areas infested with these insects. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices in floors, walls, and ceiling. <u>To Kill Firebrats, Sowby</u> and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray at the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and machinery.

<u>To Kill Fleas And Ticks</u>: Spray infested areas such as pet resting areas and areas of floor and floor coverings (such as carpet) where these pests may be present. Use at the rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet of area to be treated. Pet's old bedding should be discarded and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not apply directly to pets. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control prior to reentering treated areas.
