HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. Food processing operations do not have to be stopped while applying a wet spray with care and in accordance with the directions and cautions above in those establishments which do NOT operate under Federal meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg products inspection programs.

General: This product is designed for use undiluted in mechanical spaces that produce particles of air size.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

To Kill Gnats, House Flies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilation equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one-half (.5) ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator toward ceiling and upper corners of room. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry

To Kill Black Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae, Rice Weevils and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilation equipment. Using a cold fog generator, direct discharge into areas suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Spray until

treated surfaces are moist with deposit. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before entry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
